

ROBERT MACLEAN APPOINTED PRESIDENT OF CALIFORNIA AMERICAN WATER

Robert MacLean has been appointed President of California American Water. Mr. MacLean will dedicate significant time and energy to building and maintaining relationships with State and local officials, regulators and customers throughout California. He will also work closely with local operating staff to continue to enhance performance and customer service.

Mr. MacLean has been with American water since 2001. Prior to his new position, he was the Director of Field Operations for New Jersey American Water, the largest investor-owned water utility in the state, providing high quality and reliable water service to approximately 2.5 million people and overseeing 280 employees. Mr. Maclean has also served as the Director of Network for New Jersey American Water, where he was responsible for the management of the transmission and distribution and sewer collection systems for the company. This included over 8,000 miles of water main, over 40,000 fire hydrants and 170,000 system valves. In this role, he led the effort to achieve regulatory compliance with preventative maintenance activities in the distribution and improve customer service.

Prior to joining New Jersey American Water, Mr. MacLean served in various roles within in the American Water organization working for the non-regulated business and serving as the Vice president of Contract Operations where he was responsible for managing contracts in both the United States and Canada providing drinking water for over 4 million people and wastewater services to 1.8 million.

Mr. Maclean earned his Masters in Applied Science and Civil Engineering from Polytechnique University in Montreal and his BS in Chemical Engineering from McGill University in Montreal. Mr. MacLean is replacing Kent Turner who served as President of California American Water since 2006.
